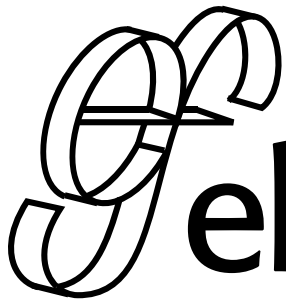

MISSION

Roger Ebert, 1964 University of Illinois Journalism graduate and Pulitzer Prize-winning film critic, comes to Urbana-Champaign each spring to host Ebertfest.

The mission of Roger Ebert's Film Festival is to praise films, genres and formats that have been overlooked by audiences, critics and distributors.

Each year, Mr. Ebert selects 12 films representing a cross-section of important cinematic works. They include films without distributors, independent and studio films that did not win wide audiences, formats such as 70mm, silent films, and overlooked genres like the documentary. The films are screened in the 1,500-seat Virginia Theatre, a restored movie palace built in the 1920s.

Festival guests who help showcase the features include producers, writers, actors and directors. Following each screening, Mr. Ebert leads discussions with the filmmakers for general audiences, distributors and critics from around the world. There are also a number of campus wide panel discussions featuring Mr. Ebert, festival guests and academic scholars.

We work to keep the festival small enough so that a sense of community can develop among the audience, filmmakers, guests, students and scholars. The festival is a non-profit event of the College of Media at Illinois.

OPPORTUNITIES

PANEL DISCUSSIONS

Filmmakers, scholars, journalists and the public gather for panel discussions on topics related to the film industry. The intent of the panels is to bring together practitioners and theorists in lively debate in order to reexamine and spotlight such issue-related areas as film directing, distribution strategies, the state of film criticism, technology, ethnicity and gender.

VOLUNTEERS

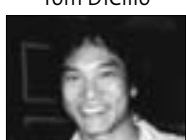

ROGER EBERT

Roger Ebert has been the film critic of the Chicago Sun-Times since 1967 and his reviews are syndicated in more than 200 newspapers around the world. He won the Pulitzer Prize for criticism in 1975.

The following year, Roger and Gene Siskel began a long run of reviewing movies on TV with “Sneak Previews,” which was followed by “At the Movies” and “Siskel & Ebert.” After Siskel’s death in 1999, he was joined by Richard Roeper on “Ebert & Roeper” until illness deprived him of the ability to speak. He and his wife Chaz now produce “Ebert Presents at the Movies,” which is syndicated on PBS stations nationwide.

Ebert is the author of more than 20 books, including the 2002 best-seller “The Great Movies,” “The Great Movies II,” “The Great Movies III,” “Awake in the Dark: The Best of Roger Ebert,” annual volumes of “Roger Ebert’s Movie Yearbook,” “Scorsese by Ebert,” “I Hated, Hated, HATED This Movie,” the Norton anthology “Roger Ebert’s Book of Film,” the best-selling “Ebert’s Bigger Little Movie Glossary, and “The Pot and How to Use It: The Mystery and Romance of the Rice Cooker.” In 2011, he released “Life Itself: A Memoir.”

For years he has attended film festivals around the world – as a critic and as a juror – and launched his own “Roger Ebert’s Overlooked Film Festival” (now known simply as “EbertFest”) in 1999, an annual event presented every April in the historic Virginia Theatre in his hometown of Champaign-Urbana, IL.

You will find Ebert’s shot-by-shot DVD commentary tracks on such titles as “Citizen Kane,” “Casablanca,” “Dark City,” and “Floating Weeds.”

Ebert is the only film critic honored with a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame. He lives with his wife, Chaz Hammelsmith Ebert, in Chicago.
